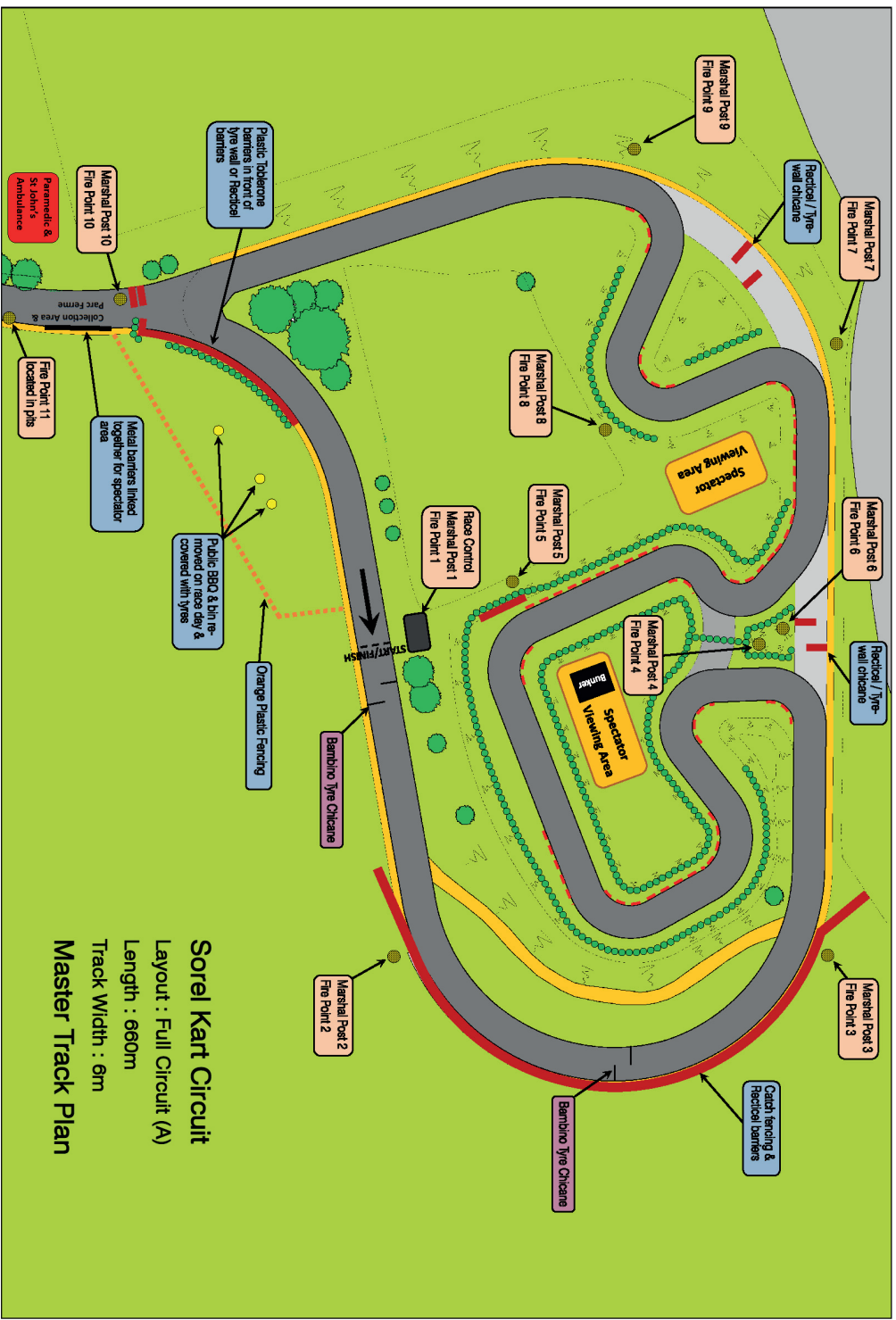

Welcome to an update on our fundraising for the new Kart track that is literally growing every day due to the hard work and determination of the committee and members of the Jersey Kart and Motor Club LBG (the Club).

We all knew that getting the planning permission was a huge challenge and achievement but that was only the beginning! We then had to raise the funds so we could start the ground works and lay the tarmac, with a very small number of club members doing much of this work in their spare time! We have had the numerous working parties bolting tyres, sifting stones, raking, painting, strapping, laying kerbs and sowing grass so that we will have an amazing track!

We have been incredibly lucky to already gather some financial support. When Belle Vue was purchased for housing there was an undertaking to help the Club locate a suitable site and develop a track on a par with what was taken away. Whilst the loop road was provided that was not an equivalent facility and the States of Jersey have kindly honoured their original promise by making a grant of £20,000 to support the Club in developing the new track.

In addition the One Foundation has supported the Club to develop the track by way of a £10,000 grant and an additional interest free loan of £10,000 that is repayable over five years, with re-payments commencing in late 2018.

With both these commitments, existing club funds, a generous donation from a club member and commitments to further funding the Club Committee was able to commit to the works you have seen to date.

However to complete all the proposed works we need to raise as soon as possible another £20,000 and then commence on-going fundraising to repay the current outstanding loans, that amount to £18,000 (tbc).

We need our members, their friends and family to assist however you can and we have a number of fund raising ideas and will ask for your support.

50 Club

The first is fairly simple and we hope as many of you as possible will join. Here's how it works... Set up (via forms supplied) a £10 per month Standing Order. This buys you one membership number which enters you into the monthly draw. All participants must be at least 18 yrs of age. The draw will take place at the monthly committee meeting each month. If you win you will receive 50% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 50% goes to the Club to help fund the track development, equipment and resources. We will be looking at opportunities to raise funds by car washes, bag packs, car boots and other wonderful ideas (if you have some please let us know). *Jersey Gambling Commission Registration Number: CR-1016-17*

Sponsorship

We are delighted to announce that we have a new sponsor for the rest of the 2017 Championship in the form of Bel Royal Motors & MAZDA, hopefully they will continue to support us in the future.

Donations

At present there is an immediate need to raise more capital to complete all elements of the track infrastructure. We are very lucky to have already received donations and indications of future support and if anyone wants to discuss how they would like to help the Club by way of a donation, no matter the amount, then please contact me.

500 Club Bonds

Not everyone is in a financial position to make a donation but if you feel you can make a £500 available to the club for a few years then you might be able to make all the difference in helping fill our funding gap.

What is proposed is that members can buy '500 Club' Bonds for £500 each. They will not bare any interest and the Club would at the AGM each year (starting 2018) draw at least two of the bond numbers for repayment. We aim to repay all bonds within 10 yrs, though this is not guaranteed and the Bonds do carry a risk of non-payment. However the Bond holders, as Club members and their family and friends, would have a personal interest in the success of the Club so we believe in the medium term all bonds would be repaid.

At present the bond paperwork is being finalised with lawyers, but if you are interested in the possibility of buying one or more bonds please again contact me in the first instance to formally register your interest.
